The court will hear from the parties regarding Defendant Nathan Fletcher's two continued motions to compel and whether meet and confer discussions have occurred with Plaintiff Grecia Figueroa's new counsel (ROA #254).

The court will also hear from the parties regarding Plaintiff's motions to compel further responses to special interrogatories ("SI") nos. 36, 37, and 50 from set three to Defendant Fletcher, and to requests for admission ("RFA") nos. 29, 33, 34, 36, and 37 from set two to Defendant Fletcher. Plaintiff did not file a reply to her motions, so the court assumes meet and confer discussions have yet to take place with her new counsel.

The court notes that based on its review of the briefing, it is very unlikely it will grant either motion, as Defendant's responses were timely, several of Plaintiff's requests are duplicative of earlier requests for which the motion to compel deadline has passed, and the requests are otherwise overbroad and ambiguous. However, regardless of how the court ultimately rules on the motions, it is very unlikely to award sanctions to either party.
